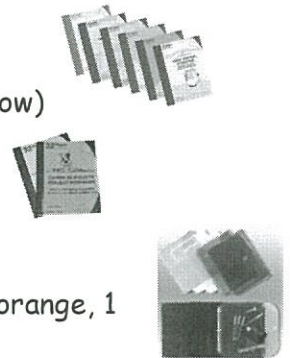
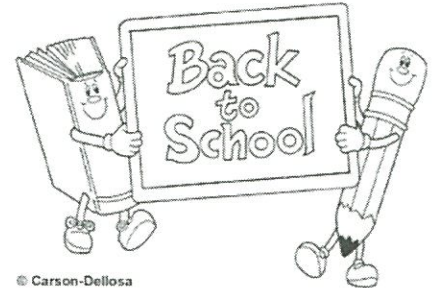

- HEALTHY snacks and lunches, with all necessary utensils every day

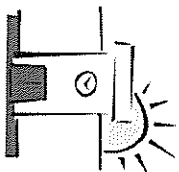
