- Register for a course and/or exam rewrite **in person** at D'Arcy McGee High School from **9:00 a.m. 12:00 p.m. and 12:30 pm to 3:00 p.m.** on the appropriate date – July 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> for review and tutorial courses, July 15<sup>th</sup>-17<sup>th</sup> for exam re-writes and History/Physical Science Review courses
- **It is mandatory to bring** your third-term report card, or, if available, **your final school report**, to confirm your eligibility, you will not be able to register without this document
- For Secondary 4 and 5 courses, bring your Ministry of Education Statement of Marks to confirm eligibility.
- Those who are writing rewrites at a different location, check with your school for exact dates and times to register: Golden Valley, Noranda, G. Theberge, and Pontiac HS.
-  For the History and Physical Science courses you will register on the exam re-write dates above since you do not receive your final mark in these courses until mid July.
- **NOTE:** History course begins on July 20<sup>th</sup>, be sure to register before then.  
 French Tutorial can be divided into separate weeks for the Grade 11's as they may not receive their final reports until after the first week the course begins.

## Re-write Final Examinations

In addition to these summer courses, there also will be re-write final examinations in Secondary II French and English, Secondary III English, Secondary IV Math (all options) and English , Math 526, Math 536, Physical Science 430, Chemistry 534 and Physics 534. These re-write exams will be available to students who failed the course or who wish to better their final mark. To qualify for a re-write final examination, the student must have previously taken the course.

These re-write final exams are scheduled from **July 31st, 2009 through to August 7<sup>th</sup>, 2009**. An exam schedule will be posted on the WQSB website showing what re-write exams are being offered, and the dates and times of each re-write exam. Upon registration, you will also receive the schedule. Prior to then, please refer to the WQSB website or contact the summer school.

## Expected dates to receive the final June 2009 marks in a course

English 516, French 594 (514), Math 514, and Physical Science 416 have Ministry of Education uniform final exams in June and August. School marks for these courses are moderated by the Ministry of Education, and the final mark in these courses is determined by the Ministry, not by the particular school. Consequently, the final June mark in these courses is **not** given on the final school report – instead, the final mark for these courses is given on the Ministry of Education Statement of Marks, which you should receive during the second week of July.

**The school regulates all courses other than those mentioned above. The final mark for these courses appears on the final school June report, which you should receive during the first week of July. Thus, some students may have to register for a summer course before they know for sure whether or not they need to take it. If a student registers for a summer course and then finds out from either the school report or the Ministry of Education report that it is not necessary, there will be a partial refund.**

## Refund Policy and Attendance Policy

### Full refund

- If a summer course is cancelled

### Partial refund

- If a student registers for a summer course and then finds out from either the school report or the Ministry of Education report that they have in fact **passed** the course, they will be refunded for the course. However, a \$20 processing fee will be withheld

### No refund

- There will be no refund if a student withdraws from a course for any other reason than those stated above.
- The re-write final exam fee is not refundable.
